
Dear colleague and user of the EnergyPLAN software,

## Interesting article on tools for analysing the integration of renewable energy

The article "A review of computer tools for analysing the integration of renewable energy into various energy systems" by H. Lund, D. Connolly, B.V. Mathiesen and M. Leahy provides the information necessary to identify a suitable computer tool for analysing the integration of renewable energy into various energy systems. The article shows that there is no energy tool that addresses all issues related to integrating renewable energy, but instead the 'ideal' energy tool is highly dependent on the specific objectives that must be fulfilled. Through the review of 37 different computer tools, the article helps the decision-maker towards a suitable energy tool for an analysis that must be completed.
